## The vine -

Plot /climat Longbois

History This plot is an enclave in the woods, located above the Champs Pimont.

Soil Silty soil, very calcareous, shallow and stony.

Our plot(s) 30a 54ca, planted in 1987 and regrafted in 2000. Located at an altitude of 310 meters, the plot sits at the edge of the woods on the upper slopes. East / southeast exposure with a gentle slope.

## The wine —

100% Chardonnay from handpicked grapes; vinified and raised in oak casks.

Taste The altitude of the plot produces wines that are precise, taut, and mineral, with notes of citrus and fresh fruits. A few remaining Pinot Noir vines bring a certain roundness to the wine.

Serving temperature 12/14°C. It is recommended to decant recent vintages so as to enhance the aroma.
