The vine —

Plot /climat Murgers des dents de Chien

History This climat is one of the most renowned in the entire village. It is a very stony area, with "Murgers" meaning "piles of stones" in the Burgundian dialect. Their sharp shapes are said to look like a dog's teeth.

Soil The soil is composed of silt and Bathonian limestone. Also, several murgers can be found nearby.

Our plot(s) 37 ares planted in 1990. Located above the Grand Cru Montrachet, this climat marks the upper boundary of the vineyard on the Puligny-Montrachet side (at 350 meters elevation).

The wine -

100% Chardonnay, handpicked grapes, raised in oak casks.

Taste Clear robe with golden-green highlights. Expressive nose combining orchard and stone fruits, with a subtle reductive note. The mouth is mineral and generous, with a saline finale. Toasty notes from the aging process add complexity and charm to this wine.

Serving temperature 12/14°C. Recent vintages may be decanted to enhance the aroma.
