The vine —

Plot /climat This site is named "Sous le bois de Noël et Belles Filles"

History They might have been nuns, strikingly beautiful, living in a convent near Changey, above Pernand-Vergelesses, who would walk down to this hillside for their strolls.

Soil Silty, sandy soils mixed with chaillots (siliceous remnants from flint limestone). The steep slope and high rainfall in Pernand-Vergelesses contribute to erosion.

Our plot(s) Located between 280 and 300 meters, Les Belles Filles is in the valley leading to Echevronne. In cooler years, the grapes struggled to ripen.

Age of vines

The wine

100% Pinot Noir from handpicked grapes; raised in oak casks.

Taste A beautiful, bright ruby color precedes aromas of red fruits and blackcurrant, and a mouth combining freshness, elegance, and fine tannins. The suppleness of the tannins suggests a wine best enjoyed within a few years; not one to forget in the cellar.

Serving temperature 15/16°C. Recent vintages may be decanted to enhance the aroma.
