The vine —

Plot /climat La Maladière (total surface area 13ha 58a)

History The name "Maladière" refers to the remnants of leper houses ("maladreries") that once treated the sick during the Middle Ages. These establishments were often located in sunny areas, away from residential homes.

Soil The soil has a reddish/ochre tint, indicating the presence of iron oxide in the clays. The subsoil, composed of limestone and dolomite, produces many small and friable rocks.

Our plot(s) Located between 240 and 280 meters. South-east exposure with a 5% slope.

The wine —

100% Pinot Noir from handpicked grapes; raised in oak casks.

Taste The wines display a deep color, with gourmet aromas of red berries (wild strawberries, raspberries) and sweet spice notes on the nose. In the mouth, they reveal a supple and delicate body supported by smooth tannins; the finish is persistent.

Serving temperature 15/16°C. It is recommended to decant recent vintages so as to enhance the aroma.
