The vine

Plot /climat Craite-Paille

History The planting campaign of the 1950s benefited this area as well as that of La Justice. These climats located at the bottom of Gevrey produce wines that are less powerful, but supple and fruity.

Soil Although located on the opposite side of the D974, Craite-Paille and its neighbor La Justice benefit from the alluvial deposits of the Lavaux combe. As such, the soil is clay-silt, well-drained, and composed of numerous limestone scree.

Our plot(s) 48 ares planted in 1970, located at the foot of the slope at an altitude of 250 meters.

The wine

100% Pinot Noir from handpicked grapes and raised in oak casks.

Taste Dressed in a ruby "Pinot Noir" tint, the wine reveals on the nose aromas of red fruits, cherries, and redcurrants. The mouth is generous, tender, and silky, with tannins that offer a delicate touch.

Serving temperature 15/16°C. Recent vintages may be decanted to enhance the aroma.
