The vine

Plot /climat Les Arvelets

History Pommard, regarded as "the flower of the wines of Beaune" since the Middle Ages, has always been synonymous with powerful, aromatic wines with great aging potential. "Arvelets" is a diminutive of the Old French Arve, meaning "fields", stretching along the Avant-Dheune valley. Another theory refers to the Micaud d'Arvelet family, who built the Château de Pommard in the 17th century.

Soil The lieu-dit is located upstream of the Avant-Dheune. The soil is thin, composed of alluvium, sand, and ferruginous marls, giving it a brownish-red tint.

Our plot(s) 31 ares located between 260 and 280 meters, facing south / south-east. The plot was planted in 2018. Situated at the exit of the Grande Combe, Les Arvelets benefit from regular airflow.

The wine

100% Pinot Noir from handpicked grapes ; raised in oak casks.

Taste The nose is marked by crispy dark fruits and sweet spices. The young vine gives the wine a vibrant fruit character. In the mouth, the attack is dense, with a smooth and delicate finish.

Serving temperature 15/16°C. It is recommended to decant recent vintages so as to enhance the aroma.
